IT Infrastructure Intern Position Summary

This internship position, in our program's technology track, requires working 20 to 40 hours per week, 5 days per week with travel to job sites. Here you'll learn "professionalism" as you interact and communicate with clients, "critical thinking" as you assess local needs or problems and "planning and execution" as you deliver the right solution, right away. This role will primarily work to shadow and support experienced system integrators, and support of back office personal.

- **In-field areas of focus include:** computer networks; telecommunications systems; security systems; and structured cable networks.
- Back-office areas of focus include: systems pre-testing / bench testing; inventory control; customer service; shipping and receiving



The outcome of this internship program track provides students with manufacturer training and certification as well as hands on experience with the cutting-edge technology systems we install and service. Additionally, this program track allows for flexibility with student's schedule to allow for continued educational studies while in the program. Clarktel provides business service technologies to other companies; requiring us to adopt normal service delivery hours of 8:30 to 4:00 PM (M-F). Reasonable schedule flexibility will be provided to our interns; but hours worked must fall within our normal service delivery hours.

APPLICANT QUALIFICATIONS FOR IT INFRASTRUCTURE INTERSHIP:

- Commitment to participating in the full sixth month program track. At the completion of the program track, Clarktel is often able to offer regular part or full-time employment to our graduates.
- Completed one year or more education studies towards a bachelor's degree in Computer or Electrical engineering; or completed certifications in computer science and or computer networking such as CCENT, CCNA, CCNP, and CCIA.
- Must have valid driver's license and reliable transportation.
- Must be available to travel from time to time to complete projects
- This position in on-site at our office located is Akron, Ohio (when not in the field supporting clients)
- Knowledge of computers, Microsoft operating system and Microsoft office suite.
- Able to read schematics and technical manuals
- Possess problem-solving ability.
- Effective written and verbal communication skills
- Works well independently and as part of a team.
